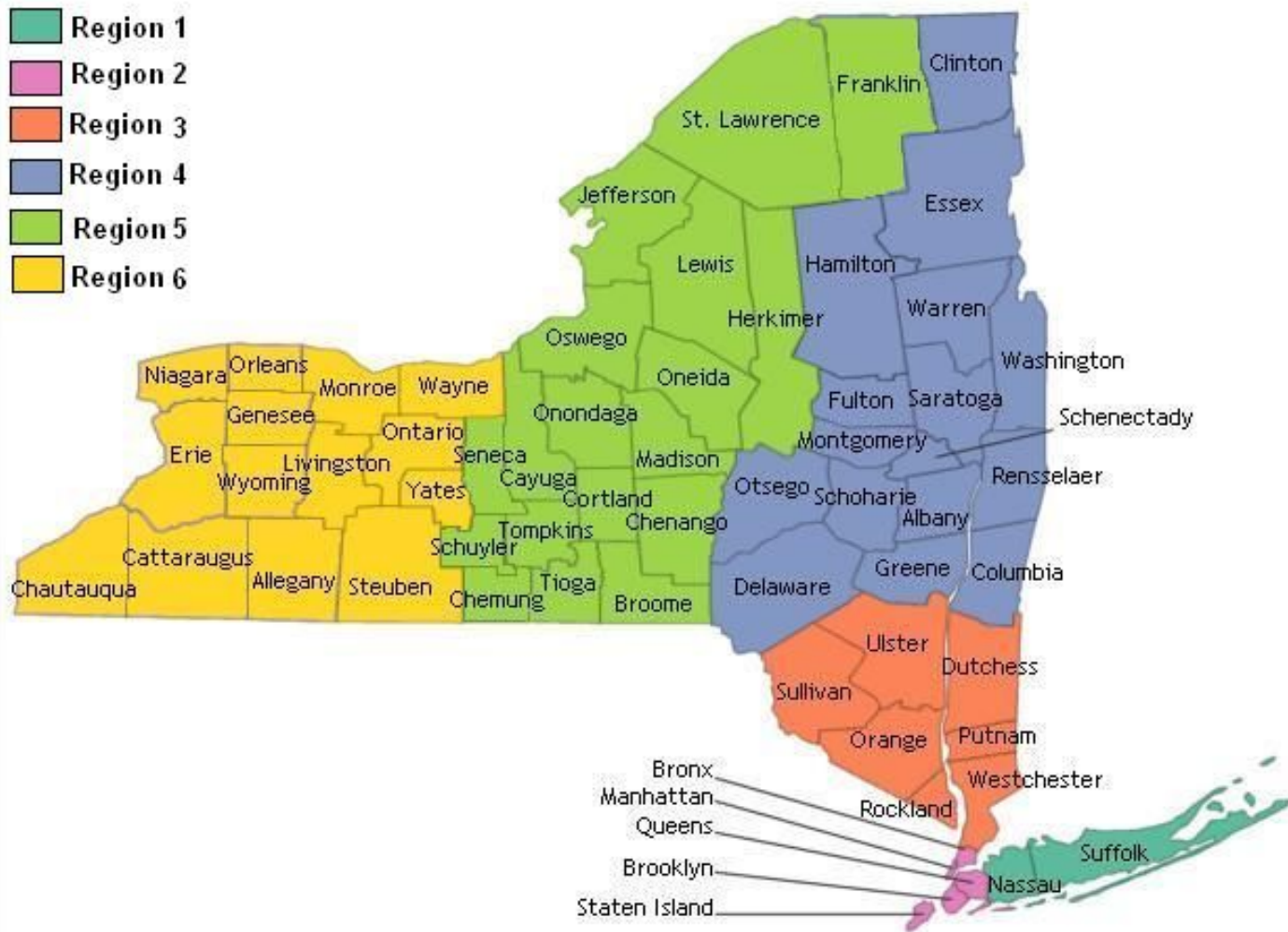
Role of NYSACAC Representative

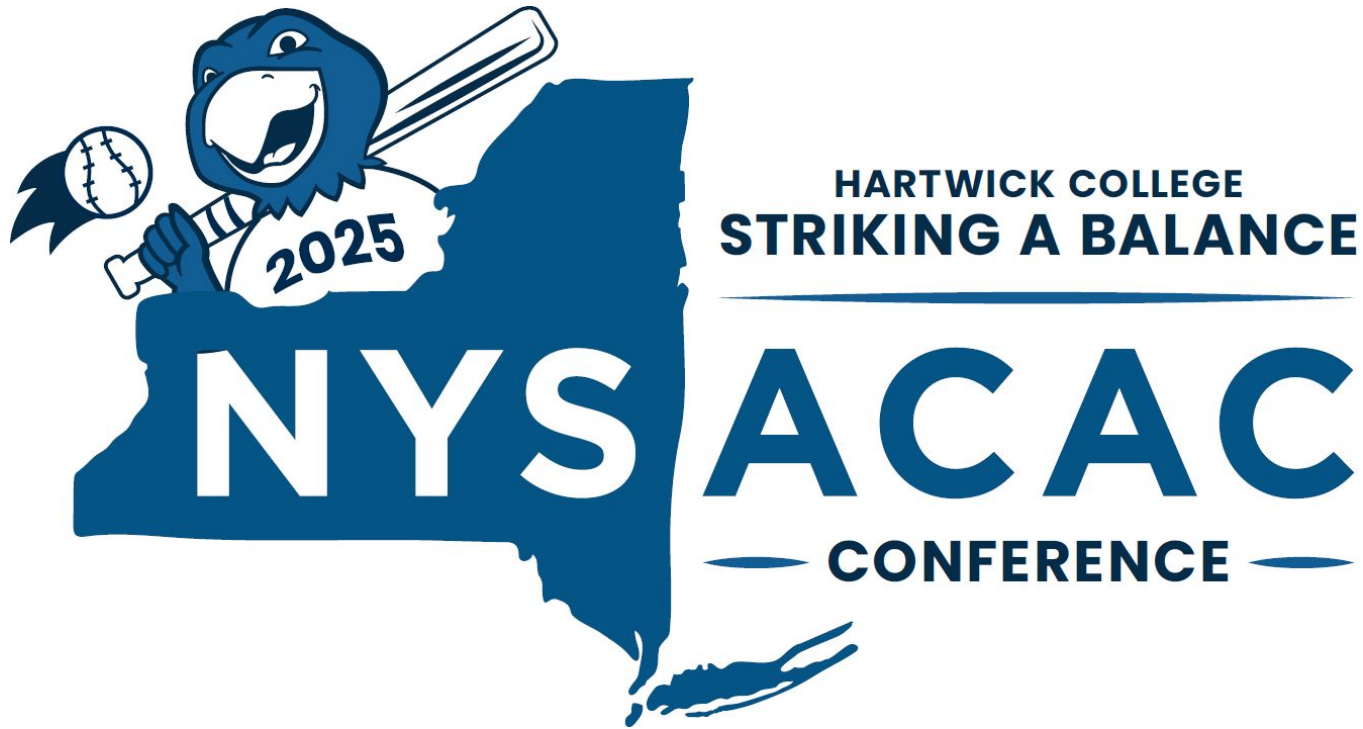
